

Non site-specific pathway

What the service offers

You may have visited your GP recently with some concerning symptoms such as weight loss, abnormal blood test results or pain that has no clear cause. These symptoms can be vague and the cause of these symptoms may remain unclear, even after your GP has assessed you and undertaken further investigations. Sometimes these symptoms can be caused by a cancer, however the risk of this is low.

Following your initial consultation at the Seamoor Unit, we may need to request further investigations for you e.g. scans or further blood tests.

Following any investigations you might have, you will be followed up in clinic with the results available for you to discuss with team members.

Where service is provided

The clinic is located in Seamoor Unit, Level 1, North Devon District Hospital, Raleigh Heights, Barnstaple, EX31 4JB

The public car park at the hospital is located on the left as you enter the main hospital site and has 285 parking and 11 disabled spaces, with an additional 10 disabled spaces outside the main entrance. There are an additional 3 disabled bays outside orthopaedics, outside Ladywell Unit.

What will happen at first appointment

You will see a clinician and/or clinical nurse specialist in an outpatient clinic. The consultation will be around 30 minutes long. The clinician may need to perform some examinations. If you would like to bring a relative or friend with you to this appointment, please do. If you have particular needs, e.g. you need assistance to get on/off couch, or other needs, please let us know in advance.
